UTAH

1 Felony Cases Resolved within One Year

STATEWIDE: **99.1%** of felony cases were resolved within 365 days of case filing.

COMPARED TO:

WI	90%
PA	89%
WA	89%
FL	88%
NC	81%

MEASURE

Measures the extent to which courts resolve felony cases within 365 days of filing in court (excludes homicide cases).

RESULTS

Three counties at one end of the spectrum and three at the other:

STANDARDS

Standards proposed by the National Center for State Courts suggest that courts should be able to dispose of 98% of felony cases within 365 days of filing.

UTAH

2 Misdemeanor Cases Resolved within Six Months

STATEWIDE: **88.1%** of misdemeanor cases were resolved within 180 days of case filing.

COMPARED TO:

FL	86%
NC	78%
WI	75%
PA	73%

MEASURE

Measures the extent to which courts resolve misdemeanor cases (e.g., petty theft, disorderly conduct, simple assault, public drunkenness) within 180 days of filing in court

RESULTS

Three counties at one end of the spectrum and three at the other:

STANDARDS

Standards proposed by the National Center for State Courts suggest that courts should be able to dispose of 98% of misdemeanor cases within 180 days of filing.
